WHAT TYPES OF SPOTS CAN BE TREATED?

Freckles, age spots, liver spots, sun spots, and dark moles are just some of the brown spots that can be effectively treated with lasers. Brown birthmarks such as café-au-lait macule and Becker's nevus can also be improved with lasers.

TREATMENTS & PROCEDURES

WHAT TYPES OF LASERS ARE USED?

The Alexandrite laser, Q-switched Nd:YAG laser, or the Intense Pulsed Light may be used to treat various brown spots. Your physician or certified nurse practitioner may choose to use just one laser, or a combination of lasers for the most effective treatment, depending on the type of brown spot.

WHO IS A GOOD CANDIDATE?

Any healthy individual with no serious medical conditions may be a good candidate.

WHAT IS THE TREATMENT LIKE?

Your skin is first numbed with a topical anesthetic to minimize any discomfort, and your eyes are protected with special goggles. The laser treatment may feel like the snap of a rubber band.

HOW MANY TREATMENTS ARE NEEDED?

The number of treatments needed depends on the condition being treated. Some spots can be completely removed with just one treatment while other lesions may require a series of treatments.

IS THERE ANY DOWNTIME?

Temporary redness and mild swelling, which usually resolves in 1 to 2 days, may occur immediately after treatment. Occasionally, some spots may darken temporarily and then gradually fade away after several days.
